Local Ballot Initiatives- Measure Y and Measure Z

Town of Yucca Valley voters will be considering two local ballot measures on the November 8th ballot.

- Measure Y - Town Essential Services (1/2 cent sales tax for 10 years)

Measure Y is a general revenue measure with funds prioritized to assist with increased public safety resources, street and road maintenance, and quality of life programming for youth and seniors.

- Measure Z - Sewer Assessment Reduction (1/2 cent sales tax for 10 years)

Measure Z is a special revenue measure to reduce the costs of the sewer assessments, equitably among all sewer phases.
