LOCATIONS

In the Morongo Basin area there are three animal shelters. The Town of Yucca Valley uses the services of Hi Dez Kennels, which is located in the Town limits. Unincorporated areas outside of the Town (i.e.; Joshua Tree, Morongo Valley, Landers), which receives animal control services from San Bernardino County, primarily uses the services of Hi Dez Kennels and the 29 Palms shelter.

Owned and Stray Pets

TURNING IN STRAY AND OWNED ANIMALS TO TOWN OF YUCCA VALLEY ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES AND HI DEZ KENNELS

How Much Does It Cost To Turn In A Stray Animal?

Nothing. There is no charge if you bring a stray animal into the shelter. It is absolutely critical that any stray animal is turned into the animal shelter that provides service to the city or area where the animal was found. This assists owners greatly in knowing where to start their search for their lost pet.

Will It Cost Me Anything For You To Accept A Pet That I Own?

The charge is \$55.00 if we send out a field unit to pick up your pet from your home. Hi Dez Kennels currently charges \$35.00 for dogs, \$20.00 for cats. For other animal shelter fees, contact the animal shelters listed above.

How Long Will The Animal Shelter Keep My Pet?

Animals turned in by their owners will be made available as soon as legally possible. Owner released and stray animals are held for five business days (as per state law) to give their owners time to find them. Found owned animals are held for 10 days to give the owner a chance to find them.

What Happens If The Shelter Can't Find A Home For My Pet?

The animals will be humanely euthanized by an injection. This is the same procedure used by private veterinarians.

Will The Shelter Call Me Before My Pet Is Put To Sleep?

No, they cannot accept the responsibility for notifying you in the event we cannot find a home for your pet. The best time to change your mind about giving up your pet is before you turn it into the animal shelter.
