## Youth Commission Appointment Guidelines

1. The Yucca Valley Youth Commission is comprised of individuals in 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades who attend school in Yucca Valley.
2. Appointments to the 2018-2019 Town of Yucca Valley Youth Commission will be limited.
3. Applications and supplementary materials must be submitted to the Community Center by **November 1, 2018**. Recommendations for appointment will be made by the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Commission.
4. Returning Youth Commissioners must submit an application to be recommended for reappointment by Community Services Department staff. Additional letters of recommendation and essay are not required - applicant recommendation will be based on the candidate's prior service.
5. Every effort shall be made to establish a representation of the most schools and grades in recommending Youth Commission appointees.
6. Youth Commissioners will be limited to serving no more than three consecutive terms if the number of applicants exceeds the number of authorized seats.
7. Commissioners will be required to attend Youth Commission meetings once a month during the school year. Excessive absences during the term will result in dismissal.
