### **6. UPDATE ON PARKS MASTER PLAN**

Director Schooler gave an update on the Parks Master Plan. He stated staff has been in contact with the consulting firm of Moore, Iacofano, Goldtsman, Inc., MIG. Currently staff is gathering the information and sending it to MIG.

Director Schooler stated that there would be three community workshops with questionnaires and interviews with the key stakeholders including representatives from the National Park, school district officials, and the organized sports groups. There will be a phone survey of approximately 2500 phone calls to get 300 interviews with local residents.

Director Schooler stated there would be news releases and radio ads to let the public know about the workshops and surveys.

## **STAFF INFORMATION**

Director Schooler reported on the Strategic Plan meetings that were held a few weeks ago. He stated that council was excited on the forward movement of the Parks Master Plan. Most of the public comments were on the need for parks and facilities.

Community Block Development Grant (CDBG) is under way. There is approximately \$141,000 for distribution in 2007-08. New this year, a sub committee was formed consisting of two council members and Director Schooler that met with each CDBG applicant. Following the sub committee meeting a recommendation was forward to Council for review and action at the February 22 Town Council meeting.

Director Schooler mentioned that the California Parks and Recreation Society conference is coming up in March.

## COMMISSIONER REPORTS AND COMMENTS

**1. Commissioner Alberg:** Commissioner Alberg mentioned someone came to him with some concerns about the Yucca Valley High School pool. He will bring that information to the March meeting. He stated that he is hoping to attend the California Parks and Recreation Society Conference in March. Commissioner Alberg mentioned that at the last Town Council meeting the current commissioners were re-ratified. He would like to talk about mentor and mentee terminology. He stated that every one is to do their best.

**2. Commissioner Falltrick:** Commissioner Falltrick inquired if the area next to Warren Vista and Yucca Trail can be cleaned up. She asked if there is going to be a Town Clean up Day in April? Commissioner Falltrick will not be able to attend the art dedication, but thanked staff for the invitation letter.

**3. Chair Hartl:** Chair Hartl stated he was glad the commission met, good to have the communication.
